
DIVERSITY MATTERS!

EQUITY

Equity is the assurance of full participation, access and opportunity for all students. Although both words are sometimes used interchangeably, equity should not be confused with equality. Equity considers individual circumstances and gives the resources needed for all people to have equal opportunity.



EQUITY MATTERS!

Equity aims to eliminate barriers that prevent the full participation of some groups. Equity ensures that all groups are treated fairly and have the tools needed to succeed.

INCLUSION

Inclusion is about bringing historically disregarded identities into the system of policies and processes and school or community activities. Inclusion gives equal access of resources and opportunities to marginalized groups. All students must feel that they are welcomed, that they belong and that they are supported in any school.



INCLUSION MATTERS!

Inclusion promotes the involvement of family and educators in supporting students from a variety of backgrounds. Schools are often a student's first encounter with inclusion. Inclusion provides a better quality of education for all children and is instrumental in changing discriminatory attitudes.
